The Salisbury Community Development Corporation (CDC) invites you to join our **Certified Contractors List** to receive bids on future home repair projects. To join, please email the attached application to Chanaka Yatawara at <u>cyata@salisburync.gov</u> or call 704-638-4474 for more information.

The Salisbury CDC is a reputable HUD-certified housing development organization specializing in the administration of federal, state, and local municipal funds for home rehabilitation, emergency repair, and new construction projects within Salisbury and across Rowan County. Funding comes from a variety of programs that include: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), the North Carolina Housing Finance Agency (NCHFA) Urgent Repair Program, the City of Salisbury, and other sources.

There are a variety of benefits to working with us. The Salisbury CDC receives **guaranteed funds** annually from the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD), the City of Salisbury, Rowan County, and the N.C. Housing Finance Agency. Our contractors appreciate the regular and steady flow of projects that we bid out. Each year, we typically bid, at minimum:

- ✓ 10 emergency repair projects (\$10,000 each)
- 10 exterior rehabilitation projects (\$20,000 each)
- ✓ 2-3 substantial rehabilitation projects (typically around \$80,000 each)
- ✓ 2-3 new constructions of single-family homes
- ✓ Various special projects (including historic restorations)

Additionally, between 2023 and 2025, the Salisbury CDC is partnering with the Town of Spencer to administer a \$750,000 housing rehabilitation grant. These funds will be used to substantially rehabilitate approximately ten (10) single-family homes in Spencer. This will be another guaranteed source of bidding opportunities for our certified contractors.

As an organization, we take pride in building strong partnerships with the contractors we work with. This is because we rely on you to keep our programs running smoothly. For that reason, contractors on our certified list enjoy priority consideration on all bids.

In other words, there has rarely been a better time to partner with us!
